The 1st greek Food Policy Council. An innovative and cooperative mechanism to address sustainability and resilience by food policymaking.

2. Food Waste and Circular Economy

influence public and private sector to support circularity

3. Gastronomy

support gastronomy events, introduce local products and producers to gastronomic professionals

The 1st urban vineyard in Greece!

About:

-Established in 2013

-Two acres area

-Previously was located the Municipality's engineering workshop

-Biological cultivation

-Four indigenous varieties

-First harvest in 2015







Varieties:

-Two red and two white varieties:

- Xinomavro
- Agiorgitiko
- Malagouzia
- Robola
- 125 vines per variety
- -350 bottles per year
- -GORGONA: the name of the wine

The Urban Vineyard

Γοργόνα - Gorgona



- -The **vinification** process is a donation of the Gerovassiliou Estate a famous winery.
- -Gorgona is given for **social** dinners or an auction with a **charity** purpose.
- -Limited wine tasting at special occasions (vineyards meetings).




Defining the purpose...


Betting on schoolyards.

WHY?

Because schools lack green space in their courtyards and Cement is the predominant material - to integrate healthy food habits.



Green roofs - edible herbs.



-Create Living Labs and events for planting edible herbs and composting plant materials to understand the importance of herbs and their properties, the need of green roofs and the composting process and meaning.

WHO?

- Projects' and actions' dissemination












